

INDY RC OPEN TRACK RULEBOOK

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Effective: 2025

1. CODE OF CONDUCT & ENFORCEMENT

Indy RC Raceway & Hobbies is committed to a safe, fair, and family-friendly environment.

Unsportsmanlike conduct, reckless driving, abusive language, intimidation, or harassment will not be tolerated. Respect fellow racers, spectators, and staff at all times.

Progressive discipline may include: verbal warning, removal from race/session, suspension, or ban.

Indy RC reserves the right to bypass any step and enforce immediate suspension or permanent ban when necessary. Management decisions are final.

2. TRACK ETIQUETTE & DRIVING STANDARDS

Respect all drivers. Announce "coming on" or "coming off" when entering/exiting. Yield to faster traffic.

No reversing, wrong-way driving, or intentional contact. Release throttle when crashed. Burnouts and tire spinning are prohibited. Stop driving when asked for maintenance or sweeping.

3. DRIVER STAND REGULATIONS

Operate vehicles only from the driver stand. Do not lean or obstruct views. No food or drinks allowed.

Radios must be handled safely. Only active drivers may occupy the stand. Arguing or shouting from the stand is not permitted.

4. PIT RULES & CHARGING SAFETY

Each driver is allotted 4 ft. of pit space. Bags must be stored beneath tables. Batteries must be supervised while charging using approved LiPo safety bags. Damaged batteries must be placed in the disposal container. SXT 3.0 is the only approved tire sauce. Food and drink only in pit areas. Keep aisles and exits clear. Report spills or damage immediately.

5. VEHICLE INSPECTION & EQUIPMENT STANDARDS

1/10 scale electric vehicles only. 2S (7.4V) LiPo max. Minimum ride height: 12mm off-road, 5mm on-road. All vehicles must be clean and pass inspection upon payment. Metal spikes, leaks, and unsafe components are prohibited. Wheelie bars, body attachments, and mounted cameras (e.g. GoPros) are not permitted. Nitro/gas vehicles not allowed indoors.

6. TURN MARSHALING REQUIREMENTS

Drivers must marshal following their race or assist during open practice. Marshals must stay alert, avoid phones, and stand in assigned corners. Retrieve cars safely by the bumper/chassis, not the wing. Treat all drivers equally. Never throw cars or parts. Step off the track during hazards.

7. SAFETY & EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

Fire extinguishers are located at every exit. Exit signs are illuminated. In case of LiPo fire, remove the vehicle from the building if safe and alert staff immediately. Notify staff before using extinguishers unless urgent. Keep exits clear. Staff may stop activity for safety.

8. TRACK MAINTENANCE & FACILITY OPERATIONS

Drivers may assist with sweeping or cleaning when necessary. Barriers may be adjusted for alignment only and must be returned to marked positions. The track layout, surface, or obstacles may not be altered without staff consent. Report damage or debris before driving resumes. No liquid cleaner or adhesive on the carpet. Only registered drivers allowed on the track. Respect the surface, keep shoes

clean, and remove all items and trash after sessions. Indy RC is not responsible for lost or stolen property.
